## FEED YOUR FAITH STARVE YOUR FEAR

Thursday, November 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:00PM

The phrase “Be Not Afraid” or “Do Not Fear” is found in the Bible 365 times. This important phrase can have a meaningful impact in our lives, even when we don’t feel that we are affected by fear.

Please join us for a talk that will help us grow spiritually and personally and help identify and address fear which deters us from becoming the MAGNIFICENT beings GOD created us to be.



In today’s Gospel Jesus is asked a trick question by the Pharisees. “Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?” He responds by asking them whose image is on their Roman coins, to which they respond simply “Caesar’s.” The coin may be stamped with Caesar’s image, but each of us is stamped with God’s image. Thus, Jesus is implying that the coin may be Caesar’s but each of us belongs to God. In that regard we should be striving to be all those things to which Jesus called us.

That is in effect what a stewardship way of life is — recognizing that God is in each of us, we are to place ourselves in service to God and to one another. That is what is really meant by “Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God.”
