Monsignor Robert C. Vogan



Rev. Msgr. Robert C. Vogan was one of the nine priests of the Philadelphia Archdiocese that has been named monsignors by Pope Francis with the title Chaplain of His Holiness.

Our pastor Monsignor Vogan has been named a Chaplain of His Holiness a title of distinction given to him by Pope Francis in recognition of his priestly serve to the Church. Only those priests who have reached the age of 65 and are considered worthy by their diocesan bishop are eligible for the Honor of Chaplain to His Holiness, with the title of Monsignor. "Monsignor" is not an appointment; rather it is an honorific form of address that can come with a title or honor granted by the Pope.

Archbishop Charles Chaput received word of the papal honors November 2nd from Archbishop Christophe Pierre, apostolic nuncio to the United States.

The honors will be conferred upon Monsignor Vogan during a vespers service with the new monsignors, other priests, bishops and guests on **Sunday, December 3rd at 4:00 p.m.** in the Cathedral Basilica of SS. Peter and Paul in Philadelphia.

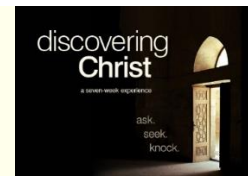
