Our readings on this final Sunday of Advent remind us that we need to imitate Mary, to be open to God's work in our lives, and to have a place for Christ in our hearts. Mary's acquiescence and acceptance of her role is such a great example of trust in God. Mary saw her role as fulfilling the purpose of God. There are similarities between God's work in Mary and His work in us. Like Mary, we should do everything we can to fulfill God's Word.

The entire letter to the Romans is a casing for the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: His purpose, His work, and His glory. One of the reasons St. Paul's letters are so powerful is that he is always reflecting on the wisdom of God's plan, and he reminds us regularly that God's wisdom is beyond us. His plan may not be ours; in fact it cannot be ours.
