**BEREAVEMENT LUNCHEON**

**Sunday, May 20<sup>th</sup> at 12:30PM Lower Church**



In today's Gospel from St. Luke, we hear the story of the two disciples walking to Emmaus who are joined en route by the risen Jesus. When the Lord first joins them, they do not recognize Him. At one point Jesus asks: "Have you anything to eat?" A ghost or spirit does not require food. Jesus was real, and in most of His resurrection appearances He dines with the disciples; we need to also understand that Jesus is real. This was the same and real Jesus doing something with them He had done many times before.

By the end of this story, the attitudes of the two men had changed completely as they moved from a dark time to a time of light. This is a good thing for us to recall in our own darkest moments, when we may doubt and despair. Jesus walks with us as a friend always on our own journeys. He is ever ready to listen to our sorrows and our doubts.

If we recognize His presence, we can experience the same healing and joy that the two men walking to Emmaus did.
